Random Drug Testing Consent Form

Statement of Purpose and Intent

Participation in school-sponsored extracurricular activities and use of the student parking lot at KCISD is a privilege. Students who participate in extracurricular activities at the high school or those who wish to obtain a school parking permit will be subject to random testing which include illegal and performance-enhancing drugs.

The Board of Trustees at KCISD has implemented this drug testing program for students in grades 9-12 who voluntarily participate in extracurricular activities at the high school level or who will be obtaining a school parking permit as one way to prevent, deter, and detect drug use among students.

Participation in Extracurricular Activities

EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITIES COVERED UNDER THIS CONSENT FORM INCLUDE:

ALL HIGH SCHOOL ATHLETICS, FFA, BAND, STUDENT COUNCIL, UIL, CHEER, HIGHSTEPPERS, YEARBOOK, CULINARY, and in other school organization that is participated in outside of class time.

Use of School Parking Lot

ANY STUDENT WHO WISHES TO PARK IN THE SCHOOL PARKING LOT DURING THE SCHOOL DAY ARE REQUIRED TO OBTAIN A PARKING PERMIT. THIS FORM GIVES CONSENT TO TEST STUDENTS WHO OBTAIN A PARKING PERMIT.

In order for a student to participate in extra-curricular activities or obtain a school parking permit, the student's parent/guardian must consent to their student's participation in the drug testing program. Student names will be placed in the random pool. A student name will remain in the random pool throughout each school year. A student participating in competitive athletics may be selected for a random drug test during his/her "off season."

Students are randomly selected from among other student participants at the same school. A student who is randomly selected will be notified to report to a designated site at the school to provide a urine sample for drug testing. A licensed professional from a state-approved, certified drug testing agency will conduct all urine sample collections. If a student refuses to provide a sample at the time of collection or provides an adulterated or fraudulent sample, it will be counted as a positive test.

Upon receiving results of a positive drug test, the Principal will schedule a meeting with the student and the student's parent/guardian to review the test results and discuss consequences. The parent/guardian will be given an opportunity to provide a medical explanation for a positive result.
